Mar

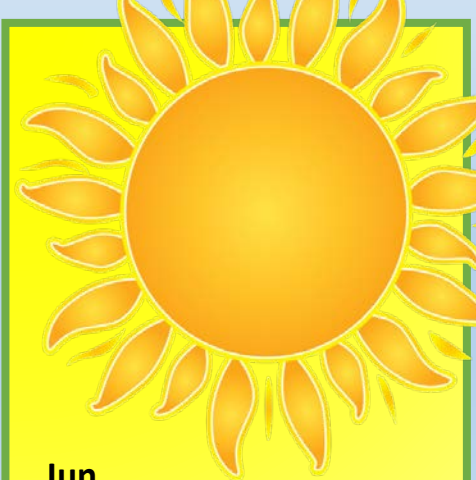
- No meeting
